The Institute of Diving (IOD) is an independent, voluntary, educational, nonprofit institution incorporated in 1977 by a group of individuals attending Sealab reunions who were seriously interested in all forms of diving and in preserving its history and artifacts.

Activities of the Institute of Diving include the operation of The Museum of Man in the Sea—formed in 1982, a library, and publication of a newsletter that addresses all forms of diving in a professionally understandable manner. An information exchange matches questions to specific resources about all aspects of diving.

The Institute corporate office and The Museum of Man in the Sea are located in Panama City Beach, Florida adjacent to many recreational and commercial diving interests in the Gulf of Mexico. Panama City Beach also provides a high degree of underwater naval support, as it is the home of the U.S. Navy Experimental Diving Unit and the Naval Diving and Salvage Training Center.

The Museum of Man in the Sea, Inc. collects, preserves and interprets all forms of apparatus used underwater including dive gear, submarines, remote operated vehicles and high tech sensor systems. Artifacts from England, Sweden, Russia, China, Japan, Italy, France, Germany, USA and Canada form the basic collection of marine history. The Museum is actively seeking to expand its library, archives and international collection through donations from all over the world.

Members are commercial, military and recreational divers from North and Central America, Europe and Asia as well as other individuals, organizations, corporations and groups interested in diving or diving-related activities. Members pay annual dues to support the Institute of Diving, the Museum, the library and publication of the quarterly newsletter. Incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida, both are Federal and State tax-exempt corporations (501) (c) (3).
