2025 Man in the Sea Museum MKV Monument Scholarship Program.

We are excited to be able to offer this scholarship to our Military Diving families and are grateful for the donations and volunteer efforts that enable us to operate. These instructions have been developed to explain the application process and to answer common questions.

Qualification of Applicants

Applicants must be the spouse, child, stepchild, grandchild, or other DOD recognized dependent of a United States Military Diver.

Children or DOD recognized dependents must be 23 years of age or younger (no age limit for spouses).

Scholarships will only be granted for initial 2 year or 4 year regionally accredited educational institution undergraduate degree programs. Graduate and professional degree programs are not eligible.

Current Service Academy Cadets, Midshipman, Active-duty service members and Veterans are not eligible for scholarship awards regardless of their relationship to a Military Diver.

Applicants can apply every year as long as they meet stated criteria

Applications will be available on January 20th, 2025. Anything sent by mail, including Official Transcripts and letters of recommendation, must be postmarked no later than April 15th, 2025. The deadline for receipt of application materials will be April 31st, 2025. *Late materials and incomplete application packages will not be considered for an award.*

Application Content

- 1. Completed scholarship application.
- 2. Sponsor signature page with both the applicant and sponsor signatures, or death certificate in lieu.
- 3. Official academic transcripts for grades 9-12 and for any college classes taken.
- 4. Letters of recommendation (from non-family members). Letters must have contact information and signature of recommenders.
- 5. Military Diver graduation certificate

AWARD EVALUATION AND CRITERIA

A committee of 5-7 volunteers representing current, former and retired Military Divers, both officer and enlisted, and their spouses will carefully read and evaluate each completed application package across the following 8 categories:

- 1. Grade Point Average
- 2. Volunteerism and Community Involvement
- 3. Extra-Curricular Activities
- 4. Awards
- 5. Employment
- 6. Essays
- 7. Letters of Recommendation
- 8. Overall Impression

Successful applicants will demonstrate strong academics with a strong writing ability, combined with community involvement and an ability to manage their time effectively. This application is a résumé to the scholarship committee. Make sure you express yourself as a great candidate by making sure that they understand what your goals are and what you have done for your community.

The amount and number of awards varies annually due to the number of qualified applicants and the funds available. Award notifications will be sent via US mail beginning on June 1st, 2025.
